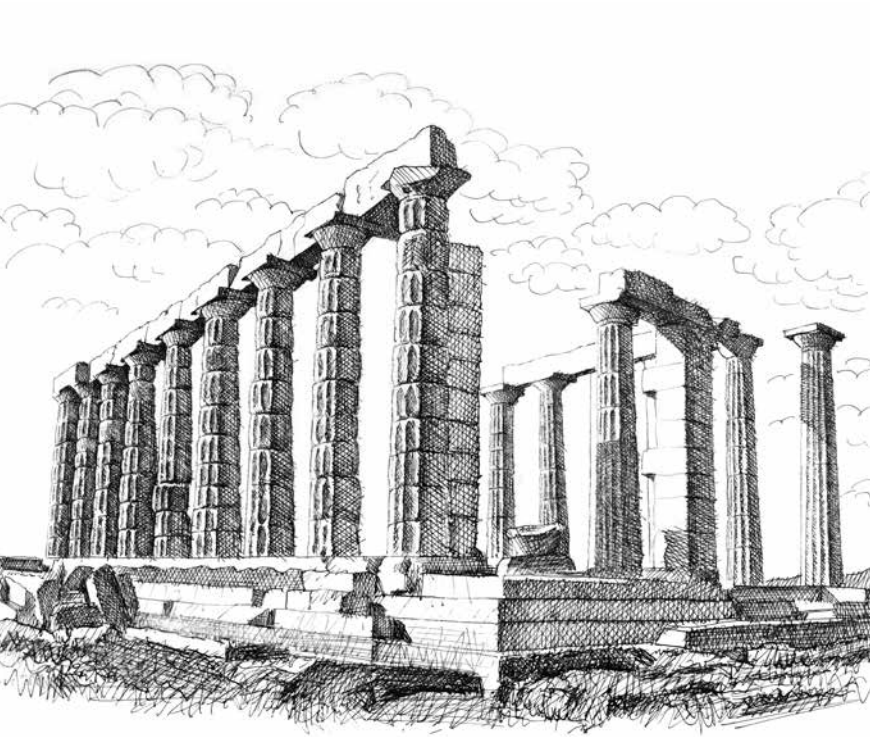

the naval symbol of the capital city of Evros prefecture, Thrace*



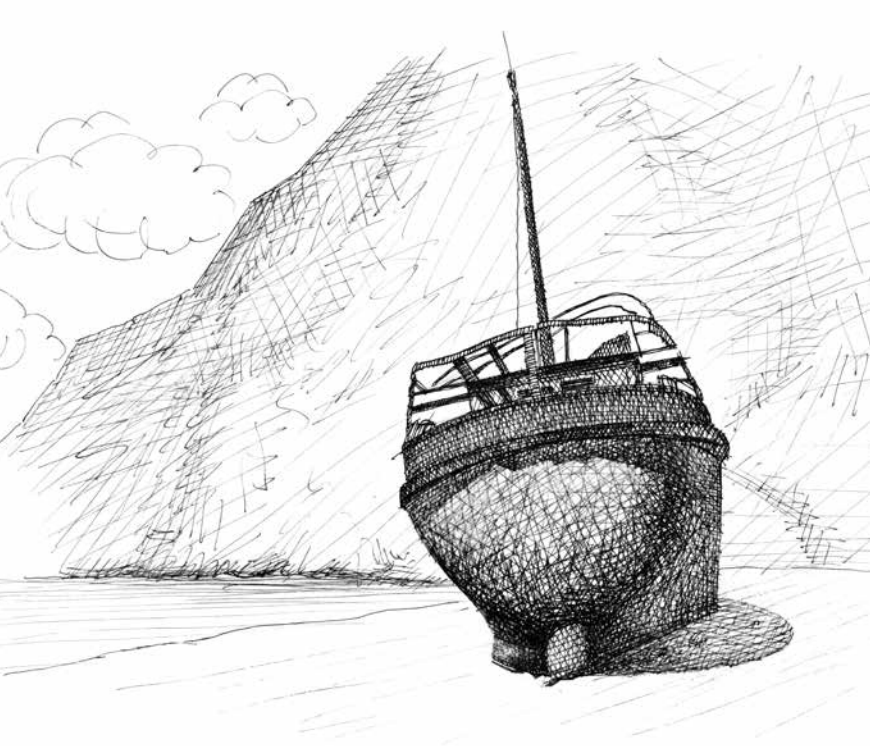

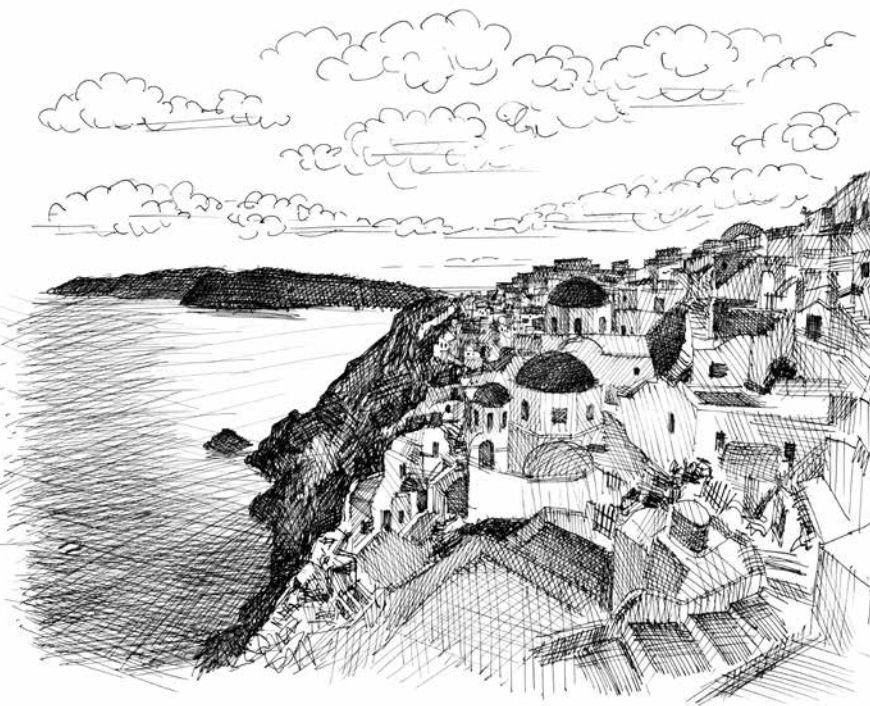
